1. *EDUCATION HOURS: The Ethics Program 2010 has been submitted to the Nebraska Department of Insurance for 3 hours of "Ethics Education" for existing Title Insurance Agents (see Neb. Rev. Stat. 44-3904), under the general authority of Neb. Rev. Stats. 44-3901 to 44-3908. The Spring Education Seminar has been submitted to the Nebraska Department of Insurance (NDOI) for 6 hours of "Continuing Education" credit and to the Nebraska Abstracters Board of Examiners (ABE) for 3 hours of Board Approved "Professional Development Credits" (see Neb. Rev. Stat. 76-544). To get 3 hours of credit, an abstracter must attend the entire Spring Education program. **There is no CE credit for partial attendance of any of the sessions.**

2. ADMISSION: Admission is only for those who have registered and paid the required fee. Name badges must be worn for proper monitoring.

3. REGISTRATION: To register for this program, fill out the Registration Form completely and return it with the fees to: NLTA, P.O. Box 85362, Lincoln, NE 68501. **NOTE:** You will be asked to furnish certain information in order to be issued a Certificate of Completion, including: your Certificate of Registration # (for abstracters credit) or NE Agents License # (for title insurance credit); and the address which you presently use in identification to NDOI (or to ABE if you are only an abstracter). This information is required so that the "Certificate of Completion" forms may be filled out properly. An attempt will be made to have your NDOI & ABE certificates of completion available at the end of the program **IF** you have provided all of the required information and have attended the entire session. If they are not available then, they will be mailed to you within ten days.
